
torneys announced in a press release today that they have filed a lawsuit against Bloomfield Township over its medical rdinances.

o the release from the office of attorney Neil Rockind, one township ordinance requires that qualifying patients and egister with police and provide information such as their name, home address, driver's license number and date of birth. inance prohibits the cultivation or distribution of medical marijuana by any registered patient or caregiver.

that the ordinances, which were passed in October 2010, are in conflict with the state's Medical Marijuana Act.


